

Lesson Title	Memory Verse	Catechism Memory Work
1) <b>God Is Faithful to Forgive</b> <i>Psalm 51</i>	As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. <i>Psalm 103:12</i> <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> I John 1:8-9	<i>The Fifth Petition:</i> And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.
2) <b>God Graciously Forgives</b> <i>Luke 23:32-43</i>	<i>For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.</i> Romans 6:23 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Romans 5:8	<i>What does this mean?</i> We pray in this petition that our heavenly Father would not regard our sins nor because of them deny our prayers; for we neither merit nor are worthy of those things for which we pray; but that He would grant us all things through grace, even though we sin daily, and deserve nothing but punishment.
3) <b>Forgiven and Forgiving</b> <i>Matthew 18:21-35</i>	And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you. <i>Ephesians 4:32</i> <b>Enrichment Verse:</b> Col. 3:12-13	<i>What does this mean?</i> And certainly we, on our part, will heartily forgive, and gladly do good to those who may sin against us.
4) <b>Our Enemy, the Devil</b> <i>Matthew 4:1-11</i>	<i>Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.</i> James 4:7 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> I Peter 5:8	<i>The Sixth Petition:</i> And lead us not into temptation.
5) <b>Escape from Temptation</b> <i>I Corinthians 10:12-14 (see also John 15:19-23)</i>	<i>No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it.</i> I Corinthians. 10:13 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Hebrews 2:18	<i>What does this mean?</i> God indeed tempts no one to sin; but we pray in this petition that God would so guard and preserve us, that the devil, the world, and our own flesh, may not deceive us . . .
6) <b>Our Sinful Hearts</b> <i>Jeremiah 17:9; Mark 7:21-23</i>	<i>The heart is more deceitful than all else and is desperately sick; who can understand it?</i> Jeremiah 17:9 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Romans 12:2	<i>What does this mean?</i> . . . nor lead us into error and unbelief, despair, and other great and shameful sins . . .
7) <b>The Battle Against Temptation</b> <i>Ephesians 6:10-20</i>	<i>Therefore, take up the full armor of God, that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.</i> Eph. 6:13 <b>Enrich.:</b> Eph. 6:17-18	<i>What does this mean?</i> . . . but that, when so tempted, we may finally prevail and gain the victory.
8) <b>God Delivers from Evil</b> <i>I Samuel 17</i>	The Lord will deliver me from every evil deed, and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom; to Him be the glory forever and ever. Amen. <i>II Timothy 4:18</i> <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Psalm 62:2	<i>The Seventh Petition:</i> But deliver us from evil.
9) <b>Look to Jesus</b> <i>Hebrews 12:1-3</i>	<i>Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance, and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith.</i> Hebrews 12:1-2a <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Phil. 3:13b-14	<i>What does this mean?</i> We pray in this petition, as in a summary, that our heavenly Father would deliver us from all manner of evil, whether it affect body or soul, property or reputation . . .
10) <b>God Keeps His Children</b> <i>Daniel 3:8-30; I Peter 1:3-9</i>	<i>“And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.”</i> John 14:3 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Jeremiah 29:11	<i>What does this mean?</i> . . . and at last, when the hour of death shall come, grant us a blessed end, and graciously take us from this world of sorrow to Himself in heaven.
11) <b>God’s Kingdom, Power, and Glory</b> <i>Acts 12:1-17</i>	<i>Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.</i> Ephesians 3:20,21 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Psalm 145:2-3	<i>The Conclusion:</i> For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.
12) <b>Amen!</b> <i>Matthew 7:7-11</i>	<i>And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Now to our God and Father be the glory forever and ever. Amen.</i> Philippians 4:19-20 <b>Enrichment Memory Verse:</b> Psalm 89:52	<i>What does the word “Amen” mean?</i> It means that I should be assured that such petitions are acceptable to our heavenly Father, and are heard by Him; for He Himself has commanded us to pray in this manner, and has promised to hear us. Amen, Amen, that is, Yea, yea, it shall be so.
