<p>1</p> <p><b>Jesus Christ, True God</b> Matthew 8:5–13</p>	<p>By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. <i>I John 4:9</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Matthew 3:17</i></p>	<p><i>The Second Article of Redemption</i> And in Jesus Christ His only Son, our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, . . .</p>
<p>2</p> <p><b>Jesus Christ, True Man</b> Luke 2:39–41, 51–52; John 4:3–29</p>	<p>And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth. <i>John 1:14</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Galatians 4:4–5</i></p>	<p><i>The Second Article of Redemption</i> . . . Born of the Virgin Mary; Suffered under Pontius Pilate, Was crucified, dead, and buried; . . .</p>
<p>3</p> <p><b>Jesus Christ, the Greatest Prophet</b> Deuteronomy 18:15–19, Luke 4:14–30</p>	<p>God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, in these last days has spoken to us in His Son. <i>Hebrews 1:1–2a</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Luke 4:18</i></p>	<p><i>The Second Article of Redemption</i> . . . He descended into hell; The third day He rose again from the dead; . . .</p>
<p>4</p> <p><b>Jesus Christ, the Great High Priest</b> Leviticus 16:1–17, Hebrews 7:26–28</p>	<p>“Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” <i>John 1:29b</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Hebrews 8:1b</i></p>	<p><i>The Second Article of Redemption</i> . . . He ascended into heaven, And is seated on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; From where He shall come to judge the living and the dead.</p>
<p>5</p> <p><b>Behold, Christ Your King</b> II Samuel 5:17–25, Matthew 21:1–11</p>	<p>“The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.” <i>Revelation 11:15b</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Zechariah 9:9b</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true Man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord; . . .</p>
<p>6</p> <p><b>Christ Redeemed Me</b> Hosea 3:1–5</p>	<p>But now, thus says the LORD, your Creator, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel, “Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine!” <i>Isaiah 43:1</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: I Peter 2:24</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, . . .</p>
<p>7</p> <p><b>No Longer Condemned</b> Matthew 8:1–4, Luke 17:12–19</p>	<p>Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. <i>Romans 8:1</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Psalm 51:1–2</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, . . .</p>
<p>8</p> <p><b>Jesus, Victorious Over Enemies</b> Matthew 12:22–29</p>	<p>But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. <i>I Corinthians 15:57</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: John 11:25–26</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . bought me and freed me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; . . .</p>
<p>9</p> <p><b>The Suffering Savior</b> Isaiah 53:3–7, Mark 15:6–32</p>	<p>All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him. <i>Isaiah 53:6</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: I Peter 1:18–19</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . not with silver and gold, but with His holy and precious blood and with His innocent sufferings and death; . . .</p>
<p>10</p> <p><b>Jesus Makes Us His Own</b> Luke 15:3–10, Isaiah 43:1</p>	<p>“For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.” <i>Luke 19:10</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: John 10:10–11</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . in order that I might be His own, live under Him in His kingdom, . . .</p>
<p>11</p> <p><b>Jesus Calls Us to Serve Him</b> Colossians 3:12–25</p>	<p>Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father. <i>Colossians 3:17</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Colossians 3:23–24</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness; . . .</p>
<p>12</p> <p><b>Jesus the King of Kings and Lord of Lords</b> Matthew 28:16–20, Revelation 4 and 5</p>	<p>“Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.” <i>Revelation 5:12b</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Matthew 28:20b</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . even as He is risen from the dead and lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.</p>
