<p>1</p> <p><b>God the Holy Spirit</b> John 14:16–18, Acts 2:1–13</p>	<p>“I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever.” <i>John 14:16</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Acts 1:8</i></p>	<p><i>The Third Article of Sanctification</i> I believe in the Holy Spirit; The holy Christian Church, The Communion of Saints; The Forgiveness of sins; The Resurrection of the body; And the Life everlasting. Amen.</p>
<p>2</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Shows Us Our Sin</b> Acts 9:1–18</p>	<p>Because by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law comes the knowledge of sin. <i>Romans 3:20</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Romans 10:4</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ my Lord, or come to Him; . . .</p>
<p>3</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Calls Us Through the Gospel</b> John 3:1–6, Acts 2:37–39</p>	<p>“It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.” <i>John 6:63</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: II Thessalonians 2:13b–14</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . but the Holy Spirit has called me through the Gospel, . . .</p>
<p>4</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Gives Faith Through Baptism</b> Matthew 28:19–20</p>	<p>Baptism now saves you—not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience—through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. <i>I Peter 3:21</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Mark 10:14b</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . enlightened me with His gifts, . . .</p>
<p>5</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Preserves Faith Through the Lord’s Supper</b> Matthew 26:26–28</p>	<p>While they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and after a blessing, He broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, “Take, eat; this is My body.” And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you; for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.” <i>Matthew 26:26–28</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: I Corinthians 10:16</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . and sanctified and preserved me in the true faith; . . .</p>
<p>6</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Sanctifies</b> Romans 7:15–25</p>	<p>“Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.” <i>John 17:17</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Philippians 1:6</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . in like manner as He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, . . .</p>
<p>7</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Gathers and Unites the Church</b> Matthew 16:13–19</p>	<p>So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God’s household, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone. <i>Ephesians 2:19–20</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Matthew 16:18–19a</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . in like manner as He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, . . .</p>
<p>8</p> <p><b>The Holy Spirit Preserves the Church</b> John 15:1–11</p>	<p>“I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.” <i>John 15:5</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: I Thessalonians 5:23</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . and preserves it in union with Jesus Christ in the one true faith; . . .</p>
<p>9</p> <p><b>The Church: One in Faith</b> Acts 8:26–40</p>	<p>What we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ. <i>I John 1:3</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: I Corinthians 12:13</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . in like manner as He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and preserves it in union with Jesus Christ in the one true faith; . . .</p>
<p>10</p> <p><b>The Church: Where Forgiveness Reigns</b> Matthew 18:19–35</p>	<p>So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. <i>Colossians 3:12–13</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: Matthew 6:14–15</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . in this Christian Church, He daily forgives abundantly all my sins and the sins of all believers, . . .</p>
<p>11</p> <p><b>The Church: Raised to Life</b> John 11:1–45</p>	<p>Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?” <i>John 11:25–26</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: I Corinthians 15:21–22</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . and at the last day will raise up me and all the dead . . .</p>
<p>12</p> <p><b>The Church: Living Forever</b> Ephesians 2:4–6, John 14:1–3</p>	<p>But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. <i>Ephesians 2:4–6</i> <i>Enrichment Memory Verse: John 14:3</i></p>	<p><i>What does this mean?</i> . . . and will grant everlasting life to me and to all who believe in Christ. This is most certainly true.</p>
