ACTIVITY 2 - ART ACTIVITY - Seeing Eye Glasses

Give each child a copy of the glasses pattern. Use heavy paper or thin cardboard for the glasses. Allow the children to decorate their glasses using glitter, crayons, or markers. Have them write their names on one of the bows and the story reference on the other bow. It may be easiest to cut the glasses out after the children have colored them.

Use a bright ribbon or yarn to make a tie so the glasses can hang around the children's necks. Punch a hole in the end of each bow to run the ribbon/yarn through. and then tie the end. Optional: Before securing the tie, thread a copy of the Bible verse on the ribbon/yam so that it hangs with the glasses.

Help the children cut out the centers of their glasses so that they can see when they put them on. Tell the children that their glasses can help them to remember Jesus healing the blind man who had never seen any colors, stars, or sunrises. Jesus also healed the man's heart by helping him to believe in Jesus and forgiving him of his sins.
