7) Jesus Meets Two Disciples <i>Luke 24:13-35</i>	“Thy Word is truth.” <i>John 17:17</i>
8) Jesus Comes to His Friends <i>Luke 24:36-49; John 20:19-29</i>	“Let not your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me.” <i>John 14:1</i>
9) Jesus Returns to Heaven <i>Luke 24:50-53; Acts 1:1-11</i>	“Lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” <i>Matthew 28:20</i>
10) The Holy Spirit Comes <i>Acts 1:1-8; Acts 2</i>	“You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you.” <i>Acts 1:8</i>
11) Jesus Has a Place for You <i>John 14:1-6; Hebrews 7:25</i>	“I go to prepare a place for you.” <i>John 14:2</i>
12) Get Ready! Get Set! Go! <i>John 14:3; Acts 1:11; I Thessalonians 4:16-17</i>	“Therefore, be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming.” <i>Matthew 24:42</i>
